- Stipend of \$10,000 for additional education expenses

- Mentoring in the first years of teaching

Eligibility:

- College seniors attending Illinois universities or colleges who are not currently on a teaching pathway
- Career-changers who hold bachelor's degrees
- Illinois residents, U.S. citizens, eligible non-citizens, or Illinois Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) students who live in or are from Illinois
- Able to commit to working in a partner school district for four years after program completion
